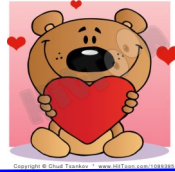
This club has faced difficult situations in the past and has survived and often prospered. Keep focused and moving forward (hard to hit a moving target). Think of all the people we're helping
